- Physically able to walk for up to approx 10 miles a day (in all weathers)!
- Capable of running (herding in), including in mud!
- Be able to work on your own initiative & independently when required.

- Have your own means of transport.

You must be prepared to adapt to a variety of tasks, including dealing with customers, assisting with refreshments & retail in our gift shop, assisting team with a Variety of animal management tasks & walking out with trekking groups.
